Dear future 8th graders,




The goal is to enrich your understanding of literature, enhance your vocabulary, and develop your ability to present and discuss the text you have read.



- Storyboard: Select 10 events and for each event do the following:
 - Create a visual illustration of the event and characters involved.

 - 4-5 sentences for each visual illustration to explain how each of the events propels the plot of the story forward.



- Break It Down Brochure: On an 8 1/2" by 11" sheet of paper, create a Book Brochure that outlines all the main information for the summer reading novel. The brochure should include illustrations as well as key information. Make sure to include the following:
